Preparation of Paper for Printed Proceedings

The authors must follow the instructions given for their articles to be published.

- The conference paper should be in A4 size with top, bottom, left and right margins of 2 cm.
- The length of the conference paper should not exceed 3 pages in Word format, pages are not numbered.
- The text of the paper must be typed by Times New Roman with 12 point size with interval of 1,15. Paragraph indentation is 1,25 cm.
- Conference proceeding materials should be organized in accordance of the following order:
 - ❖ Title in bold type, capital letters, Times New Roman, font size 14 pt and the title to be centered on the page;
 - Space;
 - ❖ The author name(s) should be typed in accordance of the following order: surname, name centered; 12 point size, Times New Roman;
 - ❖ Author(s) address and name of institution must be presented in name of organization or university, town, country, email − centered; 12 point size, italic font;
 - Space;
 - Main text.
- All figures, tables and pictures must be included in paper text; the figures and tables captions in Times New Roman with no less that 10 point size.
- All photographs and illustrations must be printed in good quality resolution.
- References must be arranged in alphabetical order and then numbered (numbers in square brackets).

Submission of conference materials for publication is **MANDATORY**. All submitted papers will be peer reviewed by members of the Organizing Committee.

The deadline for conference articles submission is 1st of JUNE 2012.

Authors are required to upload their materials electronically through the official conference website http://eng.2012.seacoasts.ru/content/about/, choose the line "Add materials" on your personal account and your "Report editing".
